

# Combat Casualty Course

**Comprehensive overview and approach to addressing injuries sustained during combat as well as everyday life.**

This course will cover the use of the personal IFAK while educating on the physiology and psychology of the body, how the body responds to stress under fire and during injury, and why it is important to have the proper training prior to an event.



- You will receive hands on application, stowage and employment of an IFAK, application of tourniquets, bandages and hemostatic agents
- basic first aid and wound care
- recognition and treatment of various injuries which may include gunshot, laceration, burn, airway, head, orthopedic and environmental.
- moving and positioning victims with various injuries, and so much more.

Numerous scenarios will be used in the aid of training. There are no prerequisites for this class.

**Required Materials:** (Bring what you have\*\*) IFAK, multiple tourniquets (CAT brand), Full kit (plate carrier, battle belt, helmet), empty magazines, snap caps NO LIVE AMMO.
