DIGNITARY/EXECUTIVE PROTECTION - SPECIALITY COURSE - 5 DAYS (40 HRS)

This 5 day course, will teach you the basics of Dignitary protection. Classes includes advance surveys, close in protection techniques, firearms handling and shooting while in close proximity of other persons, defensive tactics, caravan and precision driving, government vs corporate styles of protection and an overall understanding of personal protection.

LAW ENFORCEMENT INSTRUCTOR COURSES

PISTOL/RIFLE INSTRUCTOR - 3 DAYS (24 HRS)

This course is designed to provide departmental heads, team leaders and any officers looking to be in a instructor billet with the knowledge and skills required to efficiently and safely instruct and perform training. The course will instill the trainee with the tools to develop safe target placement and courses of fire they may utilize amongst their departments. Topics covered in this three-day course include: fundamentals of marksmanship, how to effectively teach the utilization of a pistol, developing training outlines, live-fire drill and teach-backs of student courses of fire.

SHOOT HOUSE INSTRUCTOR COURSE - 3 DAYS (24 HRS)

This 24 hour course is designed to provide departmental heads, team leaders, and any officers in a Firearms Instructor billet with the knowledge and skills required to efficiently and safely instruct and perform training within a live fire ballistic shoot house. The course will instill the trainee with the tools to develop safe movement boundaries, target placement, and courses of fire within the house and allow them to develop scenarios they may utilize amongst their departments.

INITIAL SRT OFFICER TRAINING (ISOT) - 3 DAYS(24 HRS)

The Initial SRT Officer Training(ISOT) course was developed for requests from current LE Tactical Teams to create a Close Quarters Battle(CQB) baseline for new members taught by Special Operations subject matter experts. The program serves as a sustainment/enhancement program for tactical officers that wish to remain current on the latest tactics in both deliberate and dynamic CQB styles.

The ISOT course consists of 3 days in which the team members focus on the basic principles of CQB, movement, decision-making, deconffictions, multi-room flow and weapons manipulation in a team setting.

ISOT provides the officers with a true CQB baseline and an enhanced skillset that will greatly enhance the officers effectiveness in the team. Close Quarters Tactical's CQB cadre derive from the Tier 1 and 2 levels of the SEAL teams, Army SF and other specialized units.

Teams will conduct full raids on target requiring the full usage of ISOT tactics with live role players and simmunition. The FMP will test the officers's assault skills learned in the course.

The Advanced SRT Officer Training(ASOT) course was developed for requests from current LE tactical teams to create advance Close Quarters Battle(CQB) course to enhance SRT members skillset and capabilities. ASOT is taught by tier 1 & 2 SEAL Team and Army SF subject matter experts from Close Quarters Tactical.

The ASOT course consists of 5 days in which the team members focus on the advanced principles of CQB movement, complex decision-making, team leader development, deconffictions, multi-room flow, and mechanical/manual methods of entry. ASOT takes officers to a new operating level and enhances on the officers overall capability, effectiveness and readiness.

Teams will conduct full raids on target requiring the full usage of ASOT tactics with live role players and simmunition. The FMP will test the officers's assault skills learned in the course.
